In April, 2012, d-Wizz was approached by members of John Steel Singers (JSS) to perform a short set of songs for Tim's wedding reception, which was to be held at The Zoo, in Brisbane's Fortitude Valley. A specific request was that "Love is in the Air" be one of the songs in the set. d-Wizz invited the other members of JSS to perform on stage with him.

The song was rehearsed at Wizzard! Rehearsal Rooms a couple of times before the event. It was suggested that this arrangement should be recorded for posterity. The idea was discussed for more than a year, and recording eventually started on O1 July 2013. In addition to the title track, five of d-Wizz' original songs were also selected to receive special treatment by members of JSS.

This collection consists of two volumes:

808978 contains the main versions of all six songs (11 tracks total). It is released on compact disc, cassette and a limited edition 12" vinyl record.

808967 contains remixes, instrumentals and dub versions (14 tracks). It is released on compact disc only.

The compact disc release is available as a single (808978) or double (808967) disc set

d-Wizz sang all lead vocals on the six tracks, and played all the live drums. A couple of songs use MIDI backing tracks which were programmed by d-Wizz. All other instruments and backing vocals are by members of JSS.

All songs were recorded at Wizzard! Rehearsal Rooms, and engineered and mixed by Luke McDonald of JSS, except "Love is in the Air", which was engineered by Miro. All post-production and remix/dub versions were created by d-Wizz as adaptations of the original mixes.

Some brief comments about the songs in this collection:

Love is in the Air

The most involved of all the tracks in this collection is the title track. d-Wizz sings the lead vocal and plays the live drums. Lots of additional help by JSS.

At Tim's reception, an extended jam version was performed. We attempted to reproduce this arrangement on the recording. An edited "single version" also appears on this collection without the jam session. d-Wizz made a remix of this track using the original production and additional elements.

<u>Press Play</u>

This song was written in 1995, and performed in public for the first time at Tim's reception. d-Wizz had only finished the MIDI backing track a few months earlier, using his electric drum kit to record directly to MIDI. Mitchell's Prophet '08 provided a fat bass sound. The drum sounds on the original demo were changed for this version. An acoustic version was also made for this collection.

Mammamuka

Lyrics written by d-Wizz' mother under the pseudonym The Song Factory in 1991. One of a batch of songs given to d-Wizz in 1993, soon after he began writing his own songs. The melody was composed in 1994 by d-Wizz, with the rest of the music coming in 2003, when this song was recorded for the Demo Singles Box Set #2 project. The demo recording appeared on d-Wizz' Fav Trax compilation, released in 2005. It has been a personal favourite of JSS, so d-Wizz was honoured to perform this with a few members of the band at Tim's reception. On this collection, it receives the full JSS treatment, and an extended remix by d-Wizz. d-Wizz is still working on perfectng the dance moves for the Mammamuka!

Choc-O-Block Freak

Lyrics and melody written in April, 1995 [hence the reference to Easter eggs in the song], this was always intended by d-Wizz to be a B-side, but it has evolved into one of his most popular compositions. The MIDI version was finally completed and recorded in 2003. On the demo version, d-Wizz used his "mini kit", featuring two roto toms. The same roto toms were used for the recordings in this collection. Two versions appear here; the first is a full band arrangement of the blues version, which is how the song is performed live by d-Wizz 2.0. The other is an enhancement of the original MIDI demo.

Secret Weapon

This song is another of d-Wizz' compositions that was transformed by being introduced to d-Wizz 2.0. It is now a regular part of d-Wizz 2.0's live set. When d-Wizz 2.0 began playing the song, it had not been completed by d-Wizz since its initial concept as a techno song in 1999. A completely new approach to the song led to the reggae/swing groove and brought the song alive. For this collection, d-Wizz recorded a special drum track with his electric drum kit, changing some of the drum sounds in MIDI later. Guitar and bass were played by JSS. As a special bonus, a "techno rock" version was also created by d-Wizz, which changes the song yet again, bringing it back closer to what was originally intended. This second version, which is 100% MIDI, also contains a rap breakdown by d-Wizz.

Computer Chaos

A song written in 1994 which remained just a set of lyrics for nearly 20 years. In April 2013, d-Wizz was playing with loops and came up with the bass and drum loop which forms the foundation of the track. As no melody had ever been written for the verses, it was decided to make these a rap, therefore the production is deliberately sparse. Further development of this song may be forthcoming in the future. d-Wizz invites you to enjoy the public debut of yet another unfinished song finally coming to see the light of day.
